Susan Tortolero, Ph.D., is the Director of CDC’s Texas Prevention Research Center (UTPRC) at the University of Texas School of Public Health. The UTPRC brings academic researchers, community members, and public health agencies together to collaborate on developing effective strategies to promote health and prevent disease among adolescents in Harris County and in Texas. She also directs the Center for Health Promotion and Prevention Research (CHPPR) at the University of Texas School of Public Health. The mission of the CHPPR is to conduct research to develop, evaluate, and disseminate health promotion and disease prevention programs in diverse settings and populations.

Dr. Tortolero is an Associate Professor of Behavioral Science and Health Promotion and Epidemiology. She has over 15 years of experience conducting research on risk and protective behaviors, chronic disease, and mental health among children, adolescents, and minority women. A central focus of her research concerns ethnic and cultural differences in health behaviors among youth and women.
